



The Kathleen McCarthy Bursary gives a young woman the opportunity to be educated in the Sacred Heart tradition and within our values of faith, community, integrity and kindness.

Awarded to a student commencing Year 7 studies in 2020, the Bursary will fund 75% of tuition fees to a family who may not otherwise be able to afford a Sacré Cœur education. It is available for a student currently enrolled and those who wish to attend the School.

The bursary has been established by the Foundation in the name of Kathleen McCarthy, a leading light of the Sacré Cœur community in her roles as educator, Deputy Principal, parent, School Board director and supporter.



She also served on the Foundation's Bequest sub-committee and the Alumnae Association's Janet Stuart Bursary committee. The Kathleen McCarthy Bursary encapsulates her belief in and passion for the Sacred Heart goal - Social awareness that impels to action.

It is fully means tested, with eligibility assessed annually.

#### **Eligibility criteria**

- Bursary applicants will be determined by a means-tested assessment of a family's capacity to pay fees.
- Financial eligibility will be assessed based on submission by an applicant of a Foundation - prescribed bursary application, financial hardship questionnaire and statutory declaration form.
- 3. The ongoing eligibility of bursary holder will be re-assessed annually before the end of Term 3 of the school year by the Foundation.
- 4. All standard School application and enrolment procedures must be undertaken and fulfilled where applicable.
- 5. If a recipient subsequently leaves the School prior to the conclusion of her studies, the recipient's family may be required to refund the bursary in whole or part.
- 6. The bursary is not intended to cover enrolment fees, uniforms, textbooks, camps, transport, annual building fund levy and sundry charges that may arise from time to time.
- 7. The bursary cannot be used in conjunction with any other School offer, bursary, award or scholarship.
- 8. The name and financial details of applicants shall remain confidential.

### How to apply

- 1. Complete the following forms:
  - Application form;
  - · Financial hardship questionnaire; and
  - Statutory declaration which both parties (where applicable) are to sign.
- 2. Provide a character reference. For example from a current school Principal or Parish Priest.
- 3. Provide details of the circumstances of the current financial difficulties.
